International Trip 2021 - Code of Conduct for Players and Supporters

Players are the most important people in the sport. Playing for the team, and for the team to win, is often the most fundamental part of the game, however this is not winning at any cost, as fair play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.

Please read the code of conduct below, which must be adhered to during any International Trip.

Players

- Dress smartly and appropriately and act responsibly whenever you are representing Phoenix Football Academy both on and off the field.
- Set a positive example for others and encourage teammates.
- Learn the Laws of the Game and make every effort to play by them.
- Always be on time for activities both on and off the field.
- Accept the referee's decision and do not argue with the match officials.
- Do not attempt to mislead anyone by faking an injury.
- Abide by the decisions of the coaches who are there to help you.
- Safeguard the physical fitness of all, avoid violence and unsporting play and help injured opponents.
- Control your temper and what you say and do not use foul and abusive language.
- Respect your coaches by giving good notice if you are unable to attend a session.
- Make every effort to develop your own sporting abilities in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
- Respect the tournament rules as well as the rules of the hotel or complex where you stay.
- No player is permitted to consume alcohol or take any illegal drugs during the trip.
- No player is permitted to go anywhere in Gothenburg without adult supervision, except to their own room.
- Players are NOT PERMITTED at any time to go into another player's room at the hotel.

Supporters

- Parents staying in Sweden are NOT PERMITTED to go into their son's or any other player's hotel rooms at any time.
- Supporters are reminded to act responsibly and accept the decisions of the officials when at the tournament.
- Please do not coach the players at any time. Please allow the coaches to look after the playing side of things.
- Parents please stand on the opposite side of the pitch to the players. Parents can speak with the players after the game has been completed.
- Supporters MUST not approach referees or officials to dispute any decision.
- Any appeal against a result, decision or match incident cannot be submitted by anyone other than the Head Coach of Phoenix Football Academy or the Team Head Coach.

Sanctions

Any player deemed to be breaking the code of conduct and/or putting the trip or future trips at risk may be removed from the trip. Any additional costs e.g. an early flight home due to ill-discipline that cannot be met by the player will need to be met by the parents.
